

## **Ryder for Personal Appearances**

The following Ryder is all inclusive for Kenny Aronoff to present his vibrant 60 minute program CONSISTING OF LIVE MUSIC, LIFE LESSONS, LIMITLESS STORIES ON HOW TO STAY SUCCESSFUL IN YOUR BUSINESS.

Kenny PERFORMS (PLAYS THE DRUMS) with MANY hit records that he has RECORDED on THROUGH OUT his presentation. Therefore, a PA Sound System is a must. It does not have to be concert grade but should be decent for music playback and drums. This is not for loud music but rather so the audience receives the full experience.

## **Must Have List**

8' X 8' riser for drums (if it makes sense)
8' X 8' Carpet for drum set
Sound Engineer - to mix sound (music, DRUMS and Keynote Presentation).
Duck Tape/Gaffers Tape
Projector and Screen - for Keynote (PowerPoint) presentation
One Hand Held wireless microphone on a stand
Snake or necessary cabling for 2 laptop COMPUTERS FOR MUSIC AND KEYNOTE playback
Music Stand (Manhasset if possible) – solid back
AC power must be within 6 feet of Mr. Aronoff's computers
Table - behind Mr. Aronoff that IS LARGE ENOUGH TO holds 3 lab tops with black fabric
covering
2 hours for set up and sound check with technician including a last minute sound check
before presentation

• Venue to supply a cable from HDMI Convertor or Apple Adapter to your projector in order to see the Keynote presentation.

Kenny will supply his own wireless remote, to advance pictures in Keynote Presentation. He will bring 2 Mac laptop COMPUTERS with music and Keynote presentations on it. Kenny will supply a Motu UltraLitemk3 for music. This unit is connected to MacBook Pro with fire wire cable. Mr. Aronoff will supply two ¼" male to XLR male cables; XLR cables will connect to a line /snake provided by PA company or venue to get the music to a mixing board and therefore to the PA for everyone to hear.

Kenny will supply an Apple Thunderbolt to HDMI Adapter or a Thunderbolt to HDMI/DVI/VGA Convertor for projection.

Kenny will supply an adapter from computer for his Keynote presentation audio. The adapter is a 1/8" male that converts to two  $\frac{1}{8}$ " females. He will also supply two  $\frac{1}{8}$ " male to male cables that will connect from his adapter to a snake or line provided by the PA company or venue to get the audio to a mixing board and therefore to the PA for everyone to hear.
